The chairperson Thoko Miya, gave a welcome and opening message and proceeded to give a presentation of the chapters activities from 2024 - 2025. She highlighted the other remote participation venues for the AGM and how this makes us unique when compared to other chapters.

She proceeded to highlight the changes that took place in ISOC Global and the appointment of a new Global SEO Sally Wentworth, that saw a new grant structure and changes in how grants function included an additional funding due to being amongst the top ten chapters in Africa for the year 2024.

She also mentioned the growth of our relationship with the Durban University of Technology (DUT) and how we managed to create our first ISOC Club at DUT. This work has contributed greatly to our

efforts during the South African Internet Governance Forum 2025. And also will be instrumental in the upcoming community network that we are working on in Jozini, KwaZulu-Natal.

She also mentioned the Northern Cape technical training and the DNS workshops that have need taking place over 2024 to date.

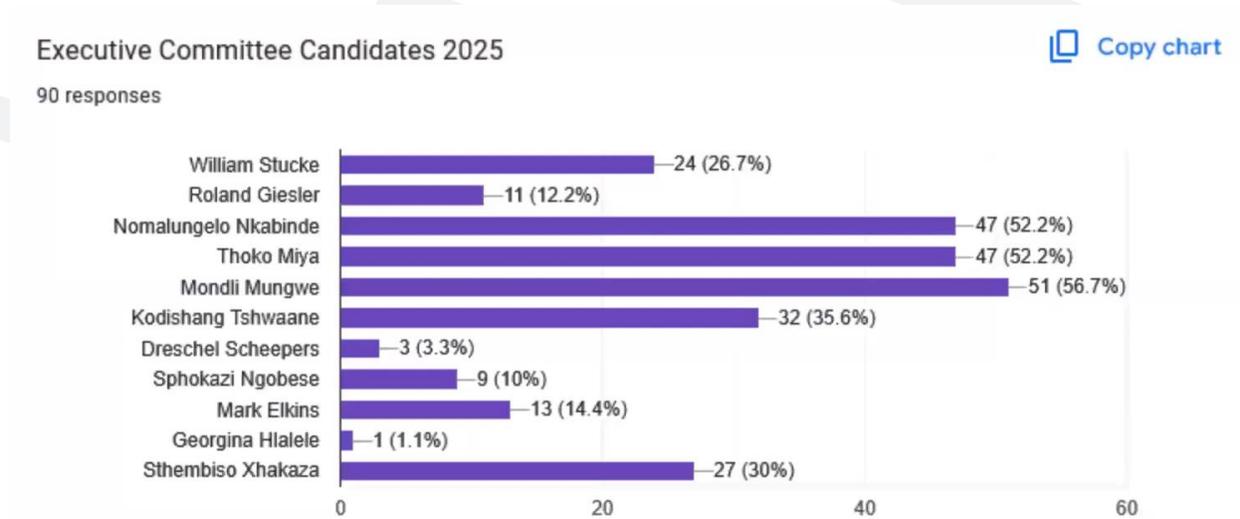
